

Friendship Friday

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Friendship Friday is designed to give Mabel Rush staff and students a clear definition of the expectations of behavior during the 11:15 am-1:15 pm lunch and recess hours. Mabel Rush staff will give direct feedback on students' behavior during their lunch and recess through the Pride Paw system. Each grade will work toward earning a specific number of Pride Paws from Monday-Thursday. The goal will be posted at the start of each week. If the grade has reached the desired number of Pride Paws after their Thursday recess, they may have Friendship Friday and earn the designated reward.

Pride Paws

- Pride Paws can be earned by grade level, not by class or individual students.
- In order to earn a Pride Paw in the cafeteria, students must be seated at their assigned table by classroom teacher.
- Students must also follow the behavior Matrix laid out for the cafeteria and recess area.
- Refer to the Behavior Matrix when giving feedback on the earning of (or lack thereof) a Paw.
- Pride Paws will **NOT** be taken away once earned.
